

RULES OF PLAY

FORMAT: 18 HOLE - Captain's Choice (SCRAMBLE)

RULES: Captain's Choice is a form of team competition popular with groups of mixed skill level whereby each member of a team gets to tee off. The team (or team captain) selects the best tee shot. The other team members pick up their respective balls and everyone gathers at the selected ball. One-by-one, each team member drops their ball at the location and plays their second. This continues until the ball is in the hole. The team receives a score for the hole, rather than individuals.


- EACH TEAM MEMBER'S DRIVE MUST BE USED AT LEAST ONCE.
- MULLIGAN SHOTS CANNOT BE USED TO WIN A CONTEST (CLOSEST TO THE PIN).
- MAXIMUM OF TWO MULLIGANS PER PERSON.... THE MULLIGANS ARE FOR THE GOLFER THAT PURCHASED THEM AND NOT FOR THE WHOLE TEAM.
- ALL PUTTS MUST BE PLAYED WITHIN ONE PUTTER HEAD LENGTH FROM THE ORIGINAL BALL AND NO CLOSER TO THE HOLE.
- PUT ONLY ONE SCORE ON THE SCORECARD.
- ONLY ONE EXTRA SHOT CAN BE TAKEN IF YOU HAVE LESS THAN FOUR PLAYERS, EXAMPLE: IF YOU HAVE ONLY THREE PLAYERS, the first PLAYER WILL PLAY A SHOT FOR SIX HOLES, the SECOND PLAYER WILL PLAY FOR SIX HOLES and the third PLAYER WILL PLAY FOR SIX HOLES. IF YOU HAVE ONLY TWO PLAYERS, ONE PLAYER WILL PLAY THE EXTRA SHOT FOR THE FIRST NINE HOLES AND THE OTHER PLAYER WILL PLAY THE EXTRA SHOT FOR THE LAST NINE HOLES.
- SPEED OF PLAY IS IMPORTANT. IF TEAM SCORE REACHES Bogey (EX: PAR 4 HOLES--5 IS Bogey), YOU MUST PICK UP AND GO ON TO THE NEXT HOLE. DO NOT HOLD UP PLAY LOOKING FOR LOST BALLS. PLAY STARTS AT 9:00 A.M.

- TIES WILL BE BROKEN BY THE LOWEST SCORES OF THE LAST HARDEST THREE HOLES—LOW SCORE WINS. IF A TIE STILL EXISTS, ADD THE NEXT THREE HOLES. IF A TIE STILL EXISTS, ADD THREE MORE HOLES UNTIL ALL EIGHTEEN HOLES HAVE BEEN USED. IF A TIE *STILL EXISTS*, THE LOWEST SCORE OF THE HARDEST HANDICAP HOLE WILL DETER-MINE THE WINNER.
- RETURN ALL SCORE CARDS TO THE SCORER'S TABLE WITH <u>TWO</u> SIGNATURES.
- ALL BALLS HIT OUTSIDE OF THE WHITE POLES <u>ARE OUT OF</u> BOUND.
- ALL LADIES WILL HIT FROM THE RED TEES.
- ALL MEN WILL HIT FROM THE WHITE TEES. (Except seniors over 65 will hit from Gold).
- PLEASE REPLACE ALL DIVOTS IN FAIRWAYS AND REPAIR ALL BALL MARKS ON THE GREENS.

GOLF ETIQUETTE:

Please smooth all marks made in Sand Bunkers. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range. Balls may be cleaned on the green, and ball marks repaired prior to putting. You may not repair spike marks prior to putting.
