The tournament will be played as a best ball format.

The rules are as follows:

- 1. Each hole will be played in a best ball format. All team members will tee off. All players will play subsequent shots from the location of the best played ball.
 - In the fairway/rough...no more than one club length away and no closer to the pin.
 - On the green...no more than one putter head away and no closer to the hole
- 2. If the foursome is not complete, then each player alternates holes to replace the missing player until the end of the round. On contest holes, only the 1st drive of the alternating player counts toward the prize.
- 3. All holes must be fully putted out before counting your team's score sorry no gimmies.
- 4. Bogey is the maximum score.
- 5. Mulligans cannot be used on Contest Hole tee shots.
- 6. Closest to the Pin tee shot must be on the green.
- 7. Longest Drive tee shot must be in the fairway.
- 8. Tee Boxes: White for men, Gold for seniors (65+), Red for ladies.
- 9. Team Prizes awarded by Gross Team Score.
- 10. Pin placement flags are red front of the green, white middle and blue back.
- 11. Turn your scorecard in at the Pro Shop.
